Date	Proposed Topic	General Overview
01/18/23	Early Childhood Special Education	This session may provide an overview of the various programs in the least restrictive environment, services, and curriculum will be reviewed. This will include resources and highlights of classroom activities, assessments and the preschool curriculum.
02/15/23	Parentally placed private school / homeschool students and the Individual Services Plan (ISP)	This session may provide overview of how LAUSD delivers alternative services to private school students who are found school/homeschool education services and attend a non-profit private school or homeschool located within LAUSD boundaries.
03/15/23	Overview of the Section 504 Plan and the Individualized Education Program (IEP)	This session may provide an overview of the Section 504 Plan and the IEP to increase awareness of the various programs available to support students with disabilities.
04/19/23	Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports and Restorative Practices (PBIS/RP) or Behavior support provided by the Division of Special Education	A collaboration between Division of Special Education and the Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports and Restorative Practices (PBIS/RP) department to provide an overview of how the District leverages a trauma-resilience informed approach through a multi-tiered system of supports framework to cultivate safe, healthy welcoming and affirming learning environments that establish a culture of learning and positive behavior.
05/17/23	English Learners with Individualized Education Programs (IEPs)	A collaboration between Division of Special Education and the Multilingual Multicultural Education Department (MMED) to present information on language acquisition needs of English Learners, reclassification data, instructional strategies, and examples of how to formulate or determine IEP goals for English Learners.
06/07/23	Disproportionality Updates	An overview of the Comprehensive Coordinated Early Intervening Services (CCEIS) supports, data, requirements and plan updates.
