

# Senior Timeline

## July-September

- Research and finalize College and Major options
- Keep track of college and scholarship application deadlines!
- **Deadlines for Private schools vary.**
- Create a professional email for college related information.
- Start your Personal Insight Questions if applying to a UC!
  - Get someone to proofread your answers.
- Register for SAT, SAT subject, or ACT-**Remember spaces fill quickly!**
  - **Send all your scores to the schools you are applying to through your CollegeBoard Account and/or ACT account!**

## October

- Begin and submit CSU applications
- Complete EOP application-You must provide contact information for two recommenders before you can submit your application.
  - Get the contact information of a counselor, or teachers who know you well and can write an EOP recommendation for you.
- Finalize UC Applications-Seek help before Thanksgiving break.
  - The website may crash on the day it is due.
- FAFSA/Dream Act applications open up October 1<sup>st</sup>.

## November

- Submit CSU/UC applications. Deadline is November 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Submit Private College applications by their respective deadlines!
- Be sure to send your SAT/ACT Scores through the Collegeboard/ACT website.
  - Keep the confirmation email for records.

## December

- Check your email for portal login instructions and log in to your portals weekly.
- Make sure you activate your portal log in and the email address given to you by the university.
- Complete CSS profile (Private Schools Only)-Deadline depends on private college!

### January-February

- o Submit FAFSA/Dream Act application to ensure schools receive your information on time.
- o When filling out the FAFSA/Dream ACT, you're going to need several things to get started.
  1. Email Address
  2. Social Security number if you have one
  3. Parents taxes from 2019
  4. Parents Date of Birth
  5. Parents Date of Marriage (if married)
  6. Parents' Social Security numbers if they have one

### March-April

- FAFSA/DreamAct Application Deadline: you must submit an application by March 2<sup>nd</sup> to be considered for Cal-Grant (for CSU/UC/Private Schools in CA) and LA Promise (for Los Angeles Community College District Schools)
- You should receive admissions decisions between February to April.
- Review Financial Aid Award Letter from schools who offer you admissions with your counselor.
- Community College bound students should register by March and follow-up with Orientation and class registration.

### May

- May 1<sup>st</sup>! Submit your statement of Intent to Register-Some campuses may require a deposit.
- If you plan to attend a CSU, find out if you have to register for the Early Start Program over summer.
- If you plan to attend a UC, you may have to take the Writing Placement exam, regardless of your major. (You may sign up for Orientation, where you will likely register for classes.
- Complete Housing application if you want secure on housing on campus-deposit required.

### June

- After graduation, submit your FINAL OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT to selected campus by July 1<sup>st</sup> (UCs) or July 15<sup>th</sup> (Check your portal for deadlines)
- **Be sure to sign onto your portal and college emails weekly!**
