Articulation of /p,b/ Bingo

Grade Level:

Preschool and Early Elementary

Curriculum:

General and Alternate Education

Targeted Skills:

Articulation- P/B

Materials:

1. Bingo board
2. Something to write with: marker, stamper, pencil, etc.

Directions:

1. Before going out, talk about the words and what they mean with your child (i.e., 'What does a bank look like? What do we do at a bank?' etc.)
2. Then, while you are out on a car ride or on a walk give your child the Bingo board and tell them to look for the items on the board. As they see the items, they will say the word (or make a phrase/sentence using the word), and mark it on their board. Once they get 5 in a row they will shout: BINGO!
3. Make a fun game out of it and incorporate other children!

Modifications/Adaptations:

- This can also be used while sitting out in the front yard or while looking through a book/magazine.
- For added language support, talk about the items as you see them. Ask questions. Describe the item (i.e., how does it look, feel, sound, smell, etc.).
