Directions (with Modifications/Adaptations):

(If you do not know which sound level your child is on, please consult with your child's speech therapist.) Practice daily with your child for at least 15 minutes.

Materials:

1. No materials are needed; pictures for articulation practice are provided below

- **Word Level:** Have your child say each word from the picture word list below 3 times each.
- **Phrase Level:** Have your child read or repeat the following phrases. As an alternative, your child may create their own phrases with each word from the picture word list.
 1. *Big ship*
 2. *Blue shark*
 3. *Hello, sheep!*
 4. *Orange shirt*
 5. *Soft tissue*
 6. *Mom's dishes*
 7. *Loud washing machine*
 8. *Dad's fishing*
 9. *Green hairbrush*
 10. *Little fish*
 11. *Backyard bush*
 12. *Strong push*
- **Sentence Level:** Have your child read or repeat the following sentences. As an alternative, your child may create their own sentences with each word from the picture word list.
 1. *There is a big ship.*
 2. *I see a shark swimming.*
 3. *That is a little sheep.*
 4. *I have an orange shirt.*
 5. *I need a tissue.*
 6. *Mom is washing the dishes.*
 7. *Put the clothes in the washing machine.*
 8. *Dad is going fishing.*
 9. *I need my hairbrush.*
 10. *I see a little fish.*
 11. *We have a bush in our backyard.*
 12. *I will push the box.*
- **Conversations:** Have your child practice their /sh/ sound in conversations by reading the following story. As an alternative, have your child create their own story involving the items in the wordlist. Make sure they are producing their /sh/ sound correctly.
 - **"Shane's Trip to the Zoo":**
 - Today is a special day. Shane is going to the zoo. Shane got up, washed his face, brushed his teeth, brushed his hair, and put on his favorite shirt. Mom said, "Before we go to the zoo, please finish some of your chores". Shane put the dirty clothes into the washing machine and helped his Mom with the dishes. When they got to the zoo, Shane pet the sheep. There were so many sheep around the bushes. One sheep was eating a bush! Next, Shane went to the aquarium in the zoo. He saw a huge shark, starfish, and many colorful fish! Before Shane went home, he picked out a cool shirt at the gift shop.
