Question	Response
<i>What does learning look like for our students with disabilities during the school closure?</i>	<p>Take-home packets with reading materials and assignments were prepared for all LAUSD students.</p> <p>Also, LAUSD has partnered with PBS, SoCal, KCET, and KLCS-TV to provide free supplemental educational resources to support learning during the school closures. This includes Pre-K–12 educational programming and online resources. The online resources are free and may be accessed at <a href="https://achieve.lausd.net/resources">https://achieve.lausd.net/resources</a></p>
<i>Will my child be provided a device and/or the assistive technology needed to access distance learning?</i>	<p>LAUSD is working diligently to ensure that all students have access to online resources and will continue providing devices to students in the next few weeks.</p> <p>For students with an already assigned assistive technology device per their IEP, LAUSD is working to ensure all assistive technology devices are made available to the student. <i>My child receives related services (i.e., Speech, Adaptive Physical Education, Occupational Therapy, etc.). Will these services be available to during the school closure?</i>	<p>Normally, students with disabilities receive direct support from providers. Due to social distancing requirements resulting from COVID-19 precautions, delivery of related services will need to be adjusted and adapted to accommodate distance learning opportunities. LAUSD is developing a plan to provide these supports to students.</p>
<i>Who do I contact regarding my child's service provider(s)?</i>	<p>Parents are encouraged to reach out to teachers and providers via email. <i>My student is on the alternate curriculum, what learning supports will be provided?</i>	<p>Teachers developed materials and resources in support of students on an alternate curriculum. Instructional online resources for alternate curriculum are available to students and parents via our LAUSD website <a href="https://achieve.lausd.net/resources">https://achieve.lausd.net/resources</a> and Unique Learning Systems (ULS).</p>
<i>Are special education centers still open?</i>	<p>No, Special Education Centers are LAUSD schools and fall under orders that all District-operated schools are to close.</p>
<i>What is the plan for Extended School Year (ESY) 2020?</i>	<p>The District will continue to plan for ESY which is tentatively scheduled for June 29-July 24, 2020. However, we understand that dependent on our situation at the time, the plan must be fluid and may change.</p>
<i>I had an IEP team meeting scheduled during the closure, will it still be held?</i>	<p>The District is developing a plan to conduct IEP team meetings remotely (i.e. teleconferencing, videoconferencing, etc.). Any IEP team meetings missed due to the COVID -19 closure will be rescheduled in accordance with this plan.</p>
<i>My child had an assessment scheduled during the closure. Will they still be assessed?</i>	<p>The District is developing a plan to conduct assessments during the school closures. Any assessments missed due to the COVID -19 closure will be rescheduled in accordance with this plan.</p>
<i>Will my child receive compensatory time for services missed during the closure?</i>	<p>Once school resumes, IEP teams will meet and make individualized determinations regarding whether or not compensatory education and services may be needed.</p>
