## RETURN TO SCHOOL FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES FAQs

QUESTION	ANSWER
Will transportation be provided for my child?	Services and supports consented to in a student’s IEP will be provided during hybrid instruction, including transportation. Students will be required to follow safety and social distancing protocols and wear appropriate PPE (i.e., masks) while on the bus.
Will the District offer Behavior Intervention Implementation (BII) District or Non-Public Agency service upon our return to school?	If a student participates in hybrid instruction and BII support is noted in their IEP, BII service will be provided while the student is participating in in-person instruction in school facilities.
How will Related Services be provided?	Students participating in the hybrid model will have related services provided in-person and virtually, as appropriate. Students participating in the virtual model will continue to receive related services virtually.
Will I have the option to keep my child at home?	Yes, parents can decide whether they would like to have their student participate in the hybrid model or continue to receive instruction virtually
If I initially select the hybrid model for my child, do I have the option to switch programs?	Yes, parents will have the option to switch from hybrid to virtual in two week intervals.
Will schools and providers have the appropriate PPE to support my child?	All school staff will be provided with appropriate PPE.
If my child needs support with personal care such as toileting and feeding will that be provided?	Services and supports consented to in the student’s IEP will be provided during hybrid instruction, as appropriate.
If my child has disability related issues with wearing a mask, can they continue to participate in the hybrid model?	An accommodation process must be followed when a student is having trouble wearing a mask.
How will IEPs be held upon our return to school?	IEPs will continue to be offered in a virtual environment. For families requiring devices and internet connectivity to participate, school sites will make space available at their school in order to provide supports. There may be an opportunity to hold in-person IEP meetings if there are a few participants and the school can accommodate physical distancing in adherence to current County guidelines.
Will my child need to be COVID tested before participating in the hybrid model?	A COVID-19 test is required at least one-week prior to returning to campus. This will ensure that your child’s daily pass application will be linked to their account.

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
