MOTION RESOLUTION

Whereas, It has been brought to the attention of the Board of Education that at some schools of the District, there may be students who are not able to eat their lunches because of the length of time they must wait in line;

Whereas, The learning environment is seriously impacted if students go to class hungry because they have not been given enough time to eat lunch;

Whereas, Parents and staff have suggested various ways to alleviate this problem; and

Whereas, To the extent such a problem exists at any school, steps should be taken to ensure that all students have an adequate time to eat; therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Board of Education instruct the Superintendent to take the following actions:

1. Evaluate every school for the amount of time scheduled for lunch, and
2. Upon review of the evaluation of the lunch periods at all schools, that each school shall develop a plan to ensure that the last child in line has no less than 20 minutes to eat; therefore, be it

Resolved further, That the Board of Education instruct the Superintendent to establish a method of monitoring each school annually for lunch schedules to ensure that all students have adequate time to eat.
