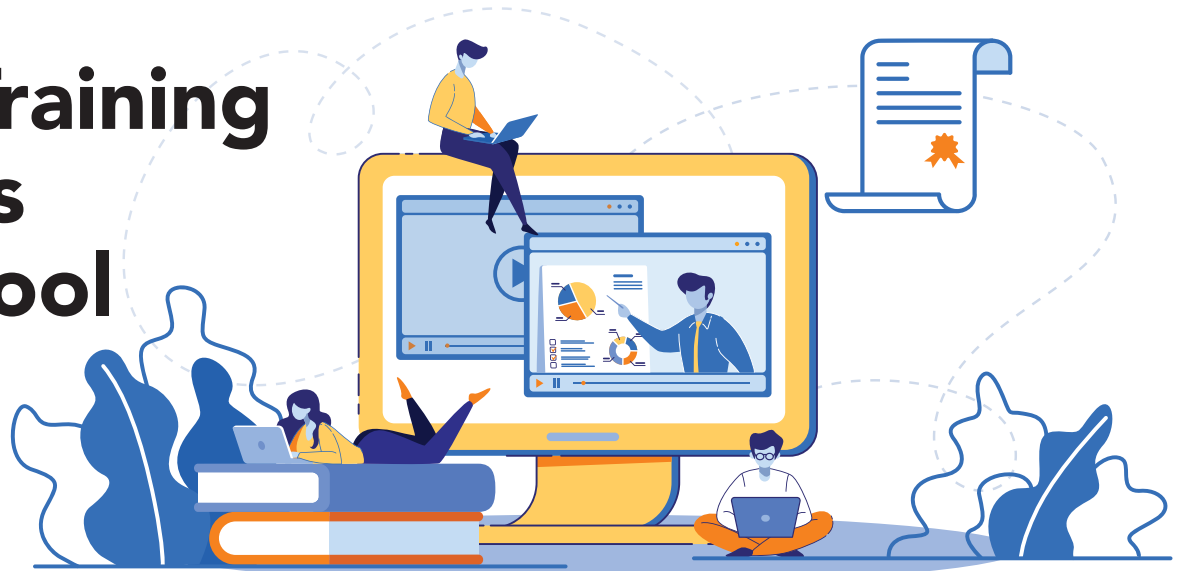


GATE Training Options for School Sites

QUESTIONING: THE DEEP DIVE

(3.5 HOURS) is an extensive exploration into how teachers can craft questions that improve student achievement, build relationships and more. This is the essence of differentiated pedagogy for gifted/talented learners. This course is equally useful for experienced and new teachers of gifted/talented learners. The course includes three hours of video (in five modules), a 30-page Course Guide for teachers, and a Facilitation Guide. L.A. ASYNCHRONOUS ONLINE GATE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

(1-2 HOURS) is available on 22 topics related to gifted/talented education. The online training opportunities are highly recommended for teachers, GATE coordinators and administrators who desire to increase their understanding of the unique needs, interests and abilities of gifted/high ability learners. Successful completion of each class will earn the participant 1-2 hours of professional development in Gifted and Talented Education (GATE). Many of these trainings are appropriate for school site professional development. A certificate of completion can be printed from MyPLN for site administrators to verify GATE professional development records.

GATE BYTES (SIMULIVE OPTIONS)

(50-55 MINUTES) Gifted/Talented Programs created NEW content to address meeting the needs of gifted/talented learners in a virtual environment. These short 50-55 minute sessions are simulative and are perfect for using at a school site Monday training. Simulative brings pre-recorded content to a live audience and presents it as if it were live. New simulative options will be added throughout the year.

Differentiation in a Virtual Setting: Session includes how to differentiate content, process and product for gifted/talented learners during distance learning. Playlists, choice boards, and bitmojis will also be highlighted as strategies during the training.
