

2020-2021 Unified Enrollment Timeline for New Dual Language Program Schools



January	Enrollment Capacity: Enrollment capacity for new Dual Language Education program schools will be entered by the Unified Enrollment office.
February-July	<p>Late Choices Application Window Opens On February 3, 2020: Parents can apply to new DLE programs and existing DLE programs. DLE programs accept late applications all year. Late applications are processed in the order received.</p> <p>New DLE schools can begin to select students who applied with a late Choices application from the list on the DLE Application Roster screen (in the Principal's Portal). Students should be selected based on the ranking assigned to the student.</p> <p>Ranking: Late Choices applicants are assigned a rank number based on when the application was received, the priorities for attendance, and language classification.</p> <p>DLE Application Roster: Principals accept or decline students in the DLE Application Roster screen (in the Principal's Portal). Provide enrollment information to parents/guardians of students that are accepted.</p> <p>Target Language Assessment: New Dual Language Education program schools must verify target language eligibility for students in grades 2 and beyond who have not been in a Dual Language Education program school. Students will appear on the late roster in the DLE Application Roster screen (in the Principal's Portal). The target language assessment can be obtained by visiting Schoology using access code: NHC9S-88WQ4.</p>
October	On-time Choices Application Window Opens: Parents can apply online or with a Choices paper application to existing Dual Language Education program schools.
November	Choices DLE On-time Application Deadline: Deadline for parents who are applying during the on-time window will occur in mid-November 2020.
December	Confirmation or Correction Letters: Confirmation or Correction letters are sent to parents/guardians who applied with an on-time application. A deadline for parents to submit corrections will be provided in the 2020-2021 school year.
