PURPOSE: The purpose of this Bulletin is to inform District personnel of the guidelines for Law Enforcement Agencies to use District facilities during non-emergency situations.

MAJOR CHANGES: This Bulletin replaces BUL-5064.1 of the same subject issued by the Office of the Chief Operating Officer, dated March 26, 2010. The revised Bulletin reflects current District organization and contact information.

GUIDELINES: I. BACKGROUND

Law enforcement agencies may request the use of District facilities for a variety of non-emergency purposes, such as operational staging areas and clandestine observation locations.

II. PROCEDURE AND AUTHORIZATION FOR NON-EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

All requests for non-emergency use by law enforcement agencies (other than Los Angeles School Police Department) for use of District facilities shall be referred to the Watch Commander at (213) 625-6631, who will notify the appropriate LASPD command staff.

AUTHORITY: This is a policy of the Board of Education of the City of Los Angeles.
