ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ◆ 8th grade middle school students who attend LAUSD middle schools
- ◆ 2.5 or better GPA
- ◆ No failing grades or unsatisfactory marks on the preceding end of year report card
- ◆ Must be endorsed by the school principal
- ◆ Must successfully complete the application process, including a personal interview
- ◆ Must be able to serve a one year term
- ◆ Experience in a school leadership position is desired but not required



DUTIES

- ◆ Attend all SSAC meetings – Approximately six times per year
- ◆ Act as a liaison between the Superintendent, Student Board Member and LAUSD students
- ◆ Share information learned with constituents at their local school sites
- ◆ Maintain a broad understanding of District and school related issues
- ◆ Engage in meaningful dialogue regarding students' views of the performance and operations of LAUSD
- ◆ Attend other events as determined
