



2021-2022 National Board Certified Teacher Opportunity

Educator Development and Support: Teachers

In 2021-2022 National Board Certified Teachers (NBCTs) will continue to have opportunities to work with school site teachers and administrators on Educator Development and Support: Teachers (EDST) to provide support on the implementation of the teacher evaluation process. Roles and Responsibilities

All NBCTs supporting teachers with the implementation of EDST are required to conduct the following activities (#1-#6):

Activity	Description	Hours
1. EDST NBC Training	Attend training to support teachers participating in EDST	1 hour web-based training or 2- hour in-person training (Limited in-person training will be provided in August/September. Dates available via MyPLN)
2. <i>Reminders</i>	Provide support with meeting EDST due dates by sending participating teachers reminders	3 hours
3. <i>Technical Support</i>	Provide technical support on the <i>My Professional Growth System (MyPGS)</i> online platform	4 hours
4. <i>Stakeholder Feedback Survey</i>	Support the online administration of the Stakeholder Feedback Survey	2 hours
5. <i>Maintain Documentation of Activities</i>	Maintain documentation of support provided at school site	1 hour
6. <i>Feedback Survey</i>	Provide feedback to EDS regarding the support provided to teachers in 2021-22	1 hour

Individual teachers participating in EDST may require additional support with the planning steps of the EDST process. Based on the requested need of individual teachers, NBC teachers may conduct the following activity:

7. <i>Process Support</i>	Provide additional support to assist teachers with the planning steps of EDST	5 hours (per assigned teacher) max
		Total hours: 14 hours maximum + 5 hours (per assigned teacher) max

Additional information

Selected NBCTs will be responsible for supporting all teachers participating in EDST at their school site, with opportunities to support teachers in neighboring schools if need is determined by EDS. If multiple NBCTs per school site are interested in this opportunity, HR-Educator Development and Support will work with the school site principal to determine need of support.
