## Participating Teacher Program Expectations

### Dispositions

'Dispositions' is the term the State of California Commission on Teacher Credentialing has adopted in the standards for Teacher Certification to represent the philosophy that teaching is more than a skill set or knowledge base. Teachers throughout the state are expected to demonstrate that in addition to subject matter knowledge and an understanding of pedagogy they have a set of dispositions that support effective teaching and learning.

Participants in the Los Angeles Unified School District working on a Provisional Intern Permit, Special Temporary Permit or University Intern Permit are expected to exhibit the dispositions identified below.

1. I will exhibit professionalism throughout my participation in the program.
2. I will be responsible for understanding and fulfilling my credential program requirements as well as honor guidelines and timelines for registration, attendance and completion of assignments.
3. I will communicate clearly, professionally and respectfully (both orally and in writing) with students, families, school & district staff and program representatives.
4. I will fully engage in reflective practice, collaboration, and program activities in a way that will demonstrate, to the best of my ability, my professional expertise and commitment to growing as a professional educator.
5. My conduct will demonstrate my commitment to personal, professional and academic integrity and my dedication to meeting my legal, moral and ethical obligations to my students, my profession and myself.
6. I will demonstrate classroom behaviors consistent with fairness, respect and the belief that all students can learn both when I am the teacher and when I am the participant.
7. I will utilize a variety of measures to assess and improve my practice including evidence gathered during my program and constructive feedback from my students, administrators, community members and program personnel. I will make a good faith effort to utilize the feedback in a positive way to increase my proficiency as an effective educator.
