Apply to become a **Social Emotional Learning Cadre Teacher Leader** for the 2020-2021 school year. As an SEL Cadre Teacher Leader, you will have the opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of SEL integration. Additionally, you will develop four SEL integrated lessons and create two videos of SEL demo lessons for possible use in future LAUSD professional development. Your lessons and videos will be resources for L.A. Unified teachers!

We will be accepting one high school teacher, one middle school teacher, and two elementary teachers from **each** Local District for a total of 24 SEL Cadre Teacher Leaders.

Compensation: Candidates who are accepted will be eligible for 40 hours of compensation at their **hourly** rate. 30 of these hours will be designated to attend professional development/meetings and the remaining 10 hours will be used to develop lessons and videos.
