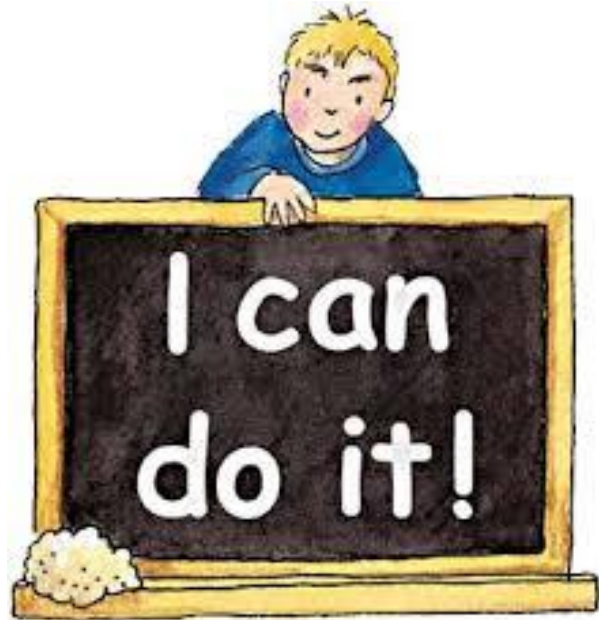


# Mastery Learning and Grading: Salary Point Class

Mastery Learning and Grading is a growth mindset approach to teaching based on the expectation that everyone can learn when provided with the right support. It offers all students and teachers an alternative to traditional instruction and grading. By refocusing classroom grading, assessment, instruction, and lesson planning on clear learning targets, and by implementing research-based systems honoring individual variation in learning styles, Mastery Learning and Grading allows more students to succeed academically and to take charge of their own learning. **This PD is for interested teachers and administrators in all grade levels and content areas.**

The class meets on three Saturdays for five hours and also includes 30 hours of independent online learning.
