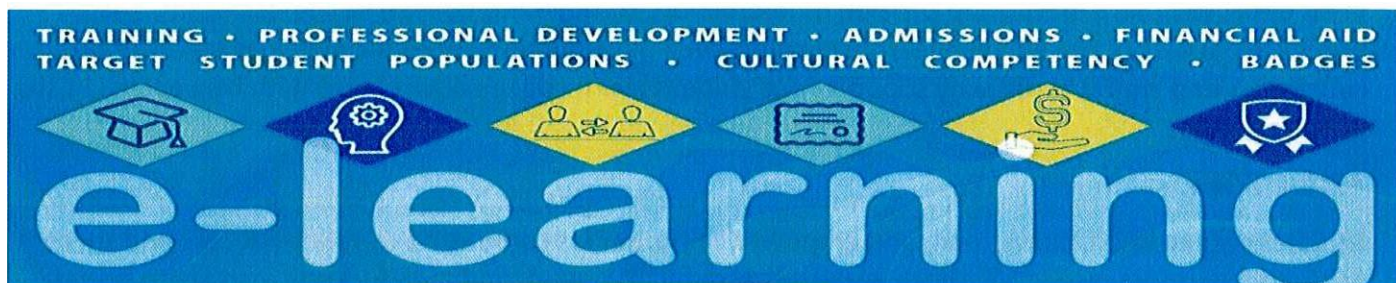
About NCAN:
