### **Public Hearing Scheduled October 6 For Williams Textbook Sufficiency Resolution**

Los Angeles (September 18, 2020) —The public will have the opportunity to comment on the sufficiency of textbooks and other instructional materials used by Los Angeles Unified during a special Board of Education meeting held no earlier than 4 p.m. Tuesday, October 6, 2020.

California Education Code requires that every student have a state-adopted, standard-based textbook or computer application to use in their English-language arts, math, history/social science, science and health classes.

Students must be assigned a single textbook (hard copy or digital copy) in each subject that they can use both at home and in class.
