DIVISIONS WHICH MET OR EXCEEDED INCIDENT RATE GOALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-13

The Office of Environmental Health and Safety (OEHS) provides critical safety and loss data quarterly to each of the Educational Service Centers and 11 of the largest operating divisions in the District. This program was designed to provide divisions with data that can be used to identify problem areas and prioritize employee injury loss activities.

The District's goal is to significantly reduce the incident rate, thereby decreasing the number of lost work days and financial burden. For Fiscal Year (FY) 2012-13, each division was given a goal of decreasing their incident rate by 5% compared to FY 2011-12. Several divisions were successful in meeting or exceeding their division specific goals for FY 2012-13.

During these trying times with increased workloads and reduced budgets, this renewal of vigor on focusing on accident reduction is remarkable. We would like to recognize and congratulate the following divisions for their success and ongoing efforts in this endeavor.
