TRAINING TOPICS

Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Sex in Education (Title IX): This online training module is designed to introduce stakeholders to roles, rights, and responsibilities under Title IX's new regulations for addressing investigation of and grievance procedures for sexual misconduct allegations occurring on or after August 14, 2020.

Title IX Complaint Manager Training: Every school site is required to have a campus Title IX Complaint Manager as a contact point for Title IX communications and concerns. This training module is focused broadly on the role of Title IX Complaint Managers, including all aspects of Title IX compliance, and conveys what every campus or office Title IX Complaint Manager needs to know to do that job and do it well.

Best Practices in Student-Related Investigations Training: This presentation provides a focus specifically on best practices in conducting student-related harassment and discrimination investigations.
