## Who Qualifies for a Bilingual Stipend?

Teachers in a dual language education program who provide instruction in the English Learners' primary language (the target language of the program i.e. Spanish, Korean, Mandarin, etc.) may qualify for a bilingual stipend if they have at least 1/3 of the students in the class that are at ELPAC levels 1-3.
