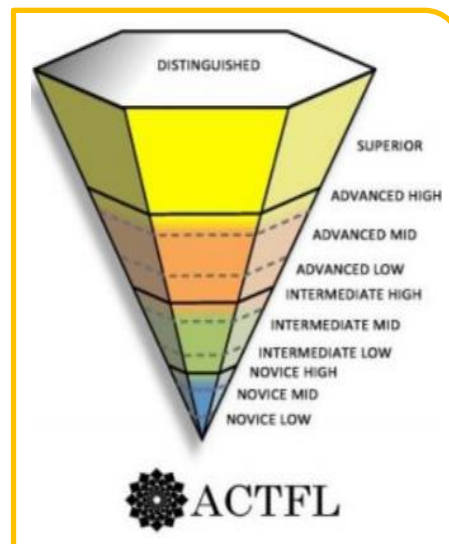
## Unified Enrollment Fairs at Peary MS and Bethune MS in October
