



How do I identify which students are at-risk of dropping out? What about those needing early intervention?

Rosters indicating at-risk information can be found in the **CLASSROOM** menu under My Students, Current Year Data dashboard. Look for the **ALERTS Reports** tab. There are two levels of alerts: **AT-RISK** and **EARLY WARNING**.

A. At-Risk Advanced Analysis Report

The purpose of this alert system is to identify "at-risk" students according to their performances across subject areas. The report triggers an **"ALARM"** whenever a student's performance falls into the "risk zone" in the observed areas. The Elementary roster lists seven at-risk indicators while the Secondary roster lists eleven at-risk indicators.

Note: The report lists all students in the classroom, whether they are at-risk or not. Follow the guide to view students who are at-risk.



Read the paragraph above the report for those thresholds.	<p>The purpose of the At-Risk System is to identify at-risk students according to their performance across multiple subject areas. It triggers an "At-Risk" whenever a student's performance falls into 1 or more of the following six areas below based on the student's CST, measure or testing comprehension for reading assessment, below proficiency for math assessment, 1 or more flags in achievement, 1 or more 1 marks in math tests, 3 or more 1 or 2 marks in math effort, 80% or below attendance, and 1 or more suspensions.</p> <p>For each flag, select "Y" if you wish to see students who are at risk for that particular factor. You should "N" you wish to see students who are not at risk. B. At-Risk Details Report

The **At-Risk Details Report** is similar to the **Advanced Analysis Report**, but it displays more information such as the assessment time, assessment score, assessment area, possible score and correct points on the assessment, course marks, days enrolled, days attended, times suspended and days suspended.

7.	The Warning Areas begin from the CST ELA Warning column up to the Attend Rate Warning column. In these columns, two performance levels, marks or rates are compared for two time periods. If there was a drop by one level, the warning will show as a "-1." The **Early Warning Summary, Details Report** is similar to the **Advanced Analysis Report**, but it actually displays the values that are being compared. These include the time periods, assessment scores, performance levels, assessment areas, and attendance rates.
