THE 12-BAR BLUES **AROUND** MUSICALLY IT DEVELOPED INTO A 12 MEASURE CHORD 1890 PROGRESSION. The 12-BAR BLUES ESPRESSES STORIES AND EMOTIONS IN A THREE LINE STANZA. **SPIRITUALS EARLY** DEEPLY EMOTIONAL RELIGIOUS MUSIC. SPIRITUALS 1800's WERE OFTEN USED AS SIGNALS TO ESCAPE SLAVERY. **EUROPEAN FOLK SONGS & HYMNS WORK SONGS** THE SLAVES CREATED HOLLERS & THE SLAVES SANG THE TUNES THEY **WORK SONGS TO TELL THEIR LEARNED IN A WAY THAT FIT THEIR** FEELINGS, COMMUNICATE WITH OWN MUSICAL STYLE.
