- Pupil Services and Attendance Counselors (PSAC) serve as liaisons between the school, the home and the FamilySource Center working on behalf of students whose home or community life presents barriers which impede educational success.
- Pupil Services and Attendance Counselors (PSAC) are experts in interpreting laws and bulletins related to education, enrollment, pupil records, and attendance policies.

- Assess and connect students referred through the Los Angeles School Police Department Diversion Referral program to FamilySource centers and other community agencies.
