

PROGRAM ELEMENTS

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Venice will implement the following programs through the Partners for Student Success Program: 1) STEM, 2) Athletics and 3) Music. Each program will be implemented for one hour a day, five days a week, for 8 weeks, and serve between 20 to 60 students. All programs can be implemented at elementary schools, middle school, high schools, and continuation option schools.

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)

- ***Hour of Code:*** An online coding education program, it is designed to demystify “code”, to show that anybody can learn the basics and broaden participation in the field of computer science. Filled with videos demonstrating how CS and coding greatly affects the world around us. Partners include Microsoft, Apple, Amazon, the College Board, and Boys & Girls Clubs of America.
- ***First LEGO Robotics:*** First LEGO League Challenge is a robotics, coding, and engineering curriculum that immerses youth in research and problem solving. The provided curriculum and supplies will guide youth to develop, design, and code a LEGO robot that navigates missions of a robot game and develop an innovative project to a real world solution.
- ***3D Printing:*** Students put their coding work into practice and learn how to create a product on the computer and code it to print 3D.

Athletics

- ***Gym:*** Non-contact sports activities. Basketball & soccer drills. Activities to get members active and introduce some physical activity into their daily routine.
- ***Sailing:*** This program offers opportunities for members 4th grade and up to learn how to sail and kayak while learning how to take care of their beaches and learn water safety. Kids are taught how to use teamwork, critical thinking, communication and self-esteem to achieve their goals. Through these activities, they set goals, listen to each other and communicate effectively, chart courses, study the wind, learn about velocity, and gain an appreciation for marine life and environmental conservation.

Music:

- ***Ukulele:*** Students, 2nd grade and up learn how to play Ukulele and master a song.
- ***Fender Play:*** Students, 5th grade and up that have completed the Ukulele class, are able to participate in Fender Play to learn guitar. Students learn the chords, chord progressions, music history, genre history and more.
- ***Angel City Youth Choral:*** Elementary school student can join the youth choral, taught in partnership with Angel City Choral. The program culminates in a performance to the public.
- ***Song Writing:*** Students of all ages are taken through the process of writing a song. To start, they come up with an idea and build lyrics around their main idea. After their song is completed, they get the chance to record the song and play the instruments. Each Club member leaves the summer program with a copy of their very own song.

BGCV's proposed program supports the District's over-arching goals of:

- ***Graduation, College and Career Readiness*** – Research has shown that programs like our STEM and music programs improve math skills and proficiencies. An ERC evaluation of our Beyond the Bell program in 2012 showed that Venice High School seniors who participated in BGCV after school programs all four years had a 96.4% graduation rate!
- ***Attendance*** – We offer engaging programs that students are eager to participate in, which support increasing school day attendance. We hit or surpass our Beyond the Bell attendance goals.
- ***Proficiency for All*** –STEM programs are designed to increase math and science proficiencies.
- ***Parent, Community, and Student Engagement*** – Our programs keep students engaged and involved. Volunteer opportunities, culmination events, sports games and tournaments, and musical performances provide opportunities to engage both parents and the community.
- ***School Safety and Positive School Climate*** – There is nothing more important than the safety of our members. We strive to create a safe, fun environment, so kids can have every opportunity to be successful in life. We do not tolerate inappropriate behavior of any kind. From strict adherence to policies and guidelines within Club facilities and staffing structure, to equipping young people with the critical thinking and social-emotional skills to make healthy, safe choices, ensuring Club members are safe is the first step to their success. We complete an annual safety assessments. Our Board led Safety Committee elevates safety to the highest level of governance.
- ***Focus on Simplicity*** – Our activities are designed to be implemented efficiently and simply without any loss of program quality and impact.
- ***Whole Child Wellness Services*** – BGCV incorporates social emotional learning into our programs. A partnership with Airport Marina Counseling Services provides on-site counseling at our Iben Family Support Center. These services will be available to all students and families.

BGCV's proposed programs also support and address the following PFSS goals.

- ***College and Career Readiness*** - Music and STEM increase proficiencies, skills and academic outcomes and introduce students to various majors and career fields associated with each program
- ***Academic Enrichment and Intervention*** –STEM builds science and math skills and improves academic outcomes. Intervention is available for students that need additional academic support.
- ***Student Engagement*** – All of our programs are designed to engage students through hands on activities and engagement strategies.
- ***Parent Engagement*** - Parents will be invited to culmination events, performances and athletic competitions to engage them in their student's activities.
- ***Health and Wellness*** – Our staff serve as positive role models. They strive to create supportive learning environments and promote and model healthy behaviors. All of the Clubs create safe learning environments to support the
- ***Community Safety Initiative*** – Safety is our number one priority. In addition to our Club's safe learning environments, BGCV conducts extensive criminal background

checks of all staff and volunteers, provides training on safety and emergency procedures, and ensures compliance with all applicable federal, state, local and District laws, regulation, and policies.
