Whereas, The Los Angeles Unified School District should encourage school sites to provide the best available and affordable technology for students and allow greater flexibility to schools to purchase technology;

Whereas, The Governing Board of the Los Angeles Unified School District and the Superintendent want to encourage schools to use their technology funds to get the most value and use for students and staff;

Whereas, Office staff and student computer labs have different software needs;

Whereas, The District hopes to distribute millions of dollars in a second round of Microsoft settlement funds;

Whereas, Separating computer bundles into different component packages will allow schools greater freedom in purchasing and could save the District millions of dollars in unnecessary computer options; and

Whereas, Schools can use the savings to purchase additional computers; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Los Angeles Unified School District’s Information Technology Division and Procurement staff will collaborate to create a revised and more flexible “shopping list” type of contract for schools and offices, which will provide greater options to purchase “bare bones” software and computers without automatically including costly components or add-ons, which will create savings for every unit purchased.
