**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Reference Guide is to provide information about the administration and training for the District’s elementary literacy assessments; DIBELS Next/IDEL 7<sup>a</sup> Edición and Text Reading and Comprehension (TRC). District Policy is that all students, TK-5, and students with disabilities in the General Education curriculum in elementary grades K-5 are administered the DIBELS Next/IDEL 7<sup>a</sup> Edición and/or TRC assessments.

The Foundational Skills (K-5) within the Common Core Reading Standards are directed toward fostering students’ understanding and working knowledge of concepts of print, the alphabetical principle, and other basic conventions of the English writing system. The CCSS accentuates the importance of these skills by explaining, “These foundational skills are not an end in and of themselves; rather, they are necessary and important components of an effective, comprehensive reading program designed to develop proficient readers with capacity to comprehend texts across a range of types and disciplines.”

**MAJOR CHANGES:** Addition of Text Reading and Comprehension (TRC). This assessment will be required for grades 4 and 5 in the 2015/2016 school year. Requirements for the use of DIBELS Next and/or TRC for grades 4 and 5. Use of DIBELS Next for reclassification for English Learners at 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

**BACKGROUND:** DIBELS Next/IDEL and TRC  
 The Amplify Electronic Platform consists of the following assessments: DIBELS Next, IDEL, and Text Reading and Comprehension (TRC).

DIBELS Next (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills) consists of a set of measures for assessing and monitoring student progress toward the acquisition of literacy skills K-5. These measures were specifically designed to quickly and reliably assess the Foundational Skills articulated in the Common Core: Phonemic



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Awareness, Print Concepts & Alphabetic Principle, Fluency with Connected Text, Vocabulary, and Comprehension.

IDEL 7<sup>a</sup> Edición (Indicadores dinámicos del éxito en la lectura) is the Spanish version of DIBELS Next, available for grades K-3.

The addition of the *TRC* assessment provides the means to electronically capture “running record” data, as well as measure students’ reading comprehension via a combination of oral and written questions requiring evidence from the text. *TRC* supports guided reading by establishing an instructional level. It also provides lessons and resources to strengthen students’ reading comprehension and competency. *TRC* supports the CCSS expectation on careful examination of the text, having the ability to read closely to draw evidence and knowledge from the text and requires students to read texts of adequate range and complexity. For school year 2014-2015, the *TRC* will not be available in Spanish. Schools that are familiar with the Amplify platform may be more ready to begin use of the *TRC* assessments. The expectation is that *TRC* will be fully utilized in the 2015-16 school year.

Used separately and/or in combination, these assessments provide teachers and schools with vital information to determine current student performance levels in the foundations of reading in order to differentiate instruction, and move all students toward effective and efficient reading at the text complexity levels established in the Common Core.

These assessments will be administered using the Amplify electronic platforms. These assessments are optimized for most touchscreen devices using Chrome<sup>™</sup> or Safari<sup>®</sup> web browsers. Please check the device compatibility information at: <http://www.amplify.com/assessment/devices>

### GUIDELINES:

#### I. ASSESSMENT GUIDELINES

Schools have access to DIBELS Next and the *TRC* assessments for grades TK-5 and may use both to provide a comprehensive picture of student’s literacy skills. Schools must use the DIBELS Next for English Learners for reclassification purposes and students with disabilities in grades TK-5.

The District is requiring schools to assess using the following guidelines.

##### A. DIBELS Next

1. Students in grades TK-2 are required to take DIBELS Next at their assigned grade-level for all three benchmarks; BOY, MOY, EOY.
2. Students in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade are required to take the DIBELS Next at BOY. If

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the student does not score at Benchmark at BOY he/she should be administered the MOY and EOY as well. If the student scores at Benchmark schools can choose to assess using either DIBELS Next or TRC for the MOY and EOY.

3. In addition to 1-2 above, students in Spanish Dual Language, Spanish Maintenance and Transitional Bilingual Education Programs will also administer IDEL 7<sup>a</sup> Edición based on their program models.
4. Students with disabilities in grades TK-5 with mild/moderate disabilities participating in the District's core curriculum take the DIBELS Next and/or TRC assessments at their assigned grade level. The assessments must be given at the accordance with the accommodations specified in the IEP or Section 504 Plan.
5. Students with moderate/severe disabilities participating in the District's alternative curriculum are not required to participate in the administration of either DIBELS Next or TRC.

6. English Learners

According to the grade-levels specified in section A, 1-2, all English Learners (ELs), including eligible ELs with disabilities, will take the DIBELS Next at MOY and EOY to determine student performance on grade-level standards as well as to provide data for reclassification.

To ensure ELs are assessed appropriately, schools must assess ELs using primary language support that matches the type of support received in daily instruction, including but not limited to translation of the assessment directions in the student's primary language by a teacher fluent in the student's primary language or a trained bilingual paraprofessional.

B. Text Reading and Comprehension or DIBELS Next

For students in 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade that are non-English learners or students with disabilities, schools have the option of administering the TRC or the DIBELS Next assessment at MOY and EOY.

4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students who are English learners or students with disabilities must be administered the DIBELS Next assessments at MOY and EOY.

II. ASSESSMENT MATERIALS  
A. DIBELS Next

Teachers that have given the assessments in prior years will continue to use the *DIBELS Next* or *IDEL 7<sup>a</sup> Edición* administration and scoring materials.

B. Text Reading and Comprehension (TRC)

Schools will receive TRC assessment kits entitled *Amplify Atlas Edition Leveled Readers*. Each kit contains K-5 assessment materials to be shared among and between grade levels, including special education teachers. Kits will be apportioned based on student enrollment.

III. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

A. DIBELS Next

Schools can access immediate training on the DIBELS Next by using the online tools found on [amplify.com/lausd/resources](http://amplify.com/lausd/resources). The training modules will walk teachers through the assessment process.

The District will also offer several Friday and Saturday 6-hour DIBELS Next trainings for teachers new to the assessment. Schools must fund the substitutes for Friday training. Teachers will be compensated at a training rate of \$25.00 per hour for Saturday training. See Attachment C for dates and registration procedures.

B. Text Reading and Comprehension (TRC)

For schools implementing the TRC, a 3-hour professional development will be offered to teachers that are familiar with the Amplify platform. See Attachment C.

IV. SCORE REPORTS

Score reports, parent reports, and instructional *Now What?* tools are available in mCLASS DIBELS immediately after administering an assessment. Using your LAUSD email login (lausd::SSO username) and SSO Password, score reports will be available at [www.mclasshome.com](http://www.mclasshome.com) from any computer connected to the Internet using Google Chrome as the browser.



V. USING RESULTS TO INFORM INSTRUCTION

After assessments are completed, *DIBELS Next* and/or *TRC* benchmark scores are to be used to inform instruction. The multi-tiered problem solving process and its use of data to drive decision-making ensures the most effective use of time, in order to best match instruction to the needs of the students. Schools may consider using results from *DIBELS Next* and *TRC* in decision making at Language Acquisition Team or Student Success Team meetings.

The Amplify platform provides a host of reporting tools to assist schools in using the data to inform instruction and provide targeted intervention as needed. These tools are most powerful when used collaboratively by grade-level teams or Instructional Leadership Teams to identify student, class, and school trends.

If the student scores at Benchmark schools can choose to assess using either DIBELS Next or TRC for the MOY and EOY.
- All students in grades 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> will be administered at MOY and EOY to allow time for teachers to have training.
- All TK-5 students who are **English Learners** must be administered DIBELS Next to measure literacy and to support Reclassification purposes.
- All Students With Mild/Moderate Disabilities in Grades TK-5 who are using the District’s core curriculum are also required to take the DIBELS Next assessment and/or TRC assessment at their assigned grade level.
