This policy applies to all schools except when noted. IS is not permitted at Community Day Schools (CDS), or Carlson Home and Hospital School.

MEM-5787.10 May 13, 2022	Back-to-School and Open House Activities for 2022-2023	The purpose of this memorandum is to provide guidelines for the scheduling of Back-to-School and Open House activities.
MEM-6015.10 May 13, 2022	School-Site Professional Development Priorities and Banked Time Tuesdays for Elementary Schools 2022-2023	The purpose of this memorandum is to provide schools with Banked Time Tuesday dates and information to enable alignment of school-based professional development content and time with District instructional outcomes and priorities.
MEM-087700.1 May 23, 2022	Administration of the 2022 School Health Profiles Survey from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention	The purpose of this memorandum is to inform secondary principals and lead health teachers of the 2022 School Health Profiles Survey. Completion of the biennial survey is required by cooperative agreement with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The survey has been in place since 1994. The survey will identify what policies and activities currently exist at school sites, and serves to guide future professional development, program improvement, and allocation of resources.
