## ANSWER SHEET - Name the Behavior



Questions to consider when conducting an investigation:

- Was the behavior severe and/or pervasive?
- Was the behavior unwanted?
- What was the intention? Was it to harm, intimidate, humiliate, engage or tease?
- Was there an injury?
- What are the ages/relationships of the involved parties?
